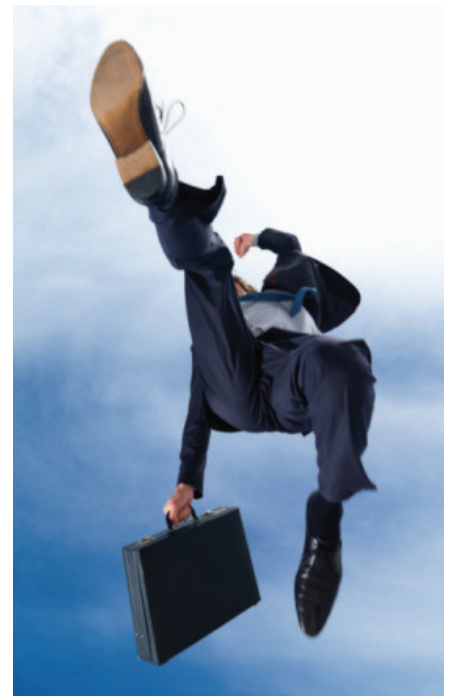

Why is it Free?

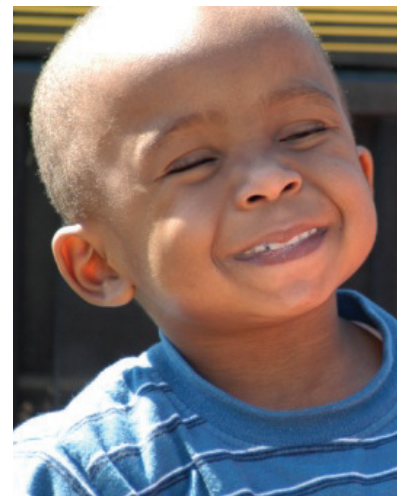
